APPLICATION DEADLINE: DECEMBER 31

The Diversity Committee invites students belonging to a racial/ethnic minority group (defined here on the basis of the majority of current SPS membership) and women to apply for the Ithiel Conrad Clemmons Student Travel Award. Students at all stages of their academic careers are encouraged to apply. The committee will grant awards based on scholarship funds available.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES:

Financial need and statement of research interests within the field of Pentecostal/Charismatic studies will be used to evaluate the applications.

1. Scholarships have been designated for members of racial/ethnic minority groups and women.
2. Applicants shall submit a 1-page letter of application containing the following:
 - a. name, address, telephone number, e-mail, academic affiliation, year in program, and SPS membership status
 - b. statement of financial need;
 - c. statement of research interests and their relation both to conference participation and the larger field of Pentecostal/Charismatic Studies
 - d. statement that identifies your ethnicity/gender and confirms that you meet the eligibility requirements for this award.
